Forklift Grapple - Grapples work along with the crowning operation of the bucket cylinder located on the excavator. They can mount directly onto the jib or whatever quick hitch which is in bucket position. Grapples are most often meant for the handling and processing of construction materials, timber, domestic and aggregate waste items. The grapple's boxed design has additional support bridging. This particular manufactured design provides the grapple with utmost support and strength by means of preventing the body from breaking and twisting all through its operation.

Each moving part which encompass the grapple, including the toes, are constructed of hardened steel. The pivot points have been specifically designed to guarantee supreme closing force and holding ability. The operator has the capacity to handle all sizes and varieties of supplies due to the jaws built-in at the end of the grapple with toes. This can enable the jaws to close through one another in a finger configuration for maximum handling capacity.
